



SSMAC'S Boucher Shines at Regional B Championships

Sault Ste Marie Aquatic Club's Emily Boucher (12) had the meet of her swimming career at the recent Dr. Jenő Tihanyi Long Course B Championships held in Sudbury June 12th and 13th. Emily swam five personal best times which translated into 4 GOLD medals and SILVER. With that performance she won the HIGH POINT TROPHY in the 11 and 12 year old girls' age group. Emily won gold in the 50 and 200 meter freestyle and the 50 and 100 meter breaststroke. The silver was won in the 100 meter freestyle.

Emily had five other SSMAC team mates competing at this end of the season regional championship meet. All five swimmers swam personal best times against some of the best swimmers in the region. Lexus Hall (13) also had a very successful meet winning GOLD in the 200 meter freestyle, SILVER in the 50 meter freestyle and 100 meter backstroke, and BRONZE in the 100 meter butterfly. She also finished 4th in the 200 meter IM. Liam Cameron (11) also swam five personal best times winning SILVER medals in the 200 meter IM, 50 and 100 meter freestyle. Liam also swam to an impressive 4th and 5th place results. Noah Janzen (13) swam 4 personal best times to achieve four top ten results, a 4th – 200 IM, 7th – 50 back, 8th 50 fly and 9th. Kate Mohammadi (12) swam away with three personal best times on way to 3 – 5th, 7th and 8th place ribbons. Kanchi Biajal also had a very successful meet by swimming to five personal best times to finish with a 6th, 2 – 7th, and 8th place ribbons.

Overall, these six swimmers totalled 12 medals and 25 personal best times. Head Coach Stratton and all his staff take this opportunity to congratulate all swimmers on their many successes through the season and to wish everyone of them to have a safe and enjoyable summer. See you in the fall.
